The successful candidate must have a record of outstanding scholarship and a commitment to excellence in undergraduate and graduate engineering education. Applicants with research interests in the thermo-fluid area of mechanical engineering or any areas of aerospace engineering are encouraged to apply. The successful candidate will be expected to teach undergraduate courses in mechanical engineering, graduate engineering courses relevant to their expertise, and develop a successful program of scholarly research, including external funding and publication.
